During the fourth transnational meeting, the project partners have discussed the finalization of the Need Analysis and the Strategy paper. By this time the Need Analysis is almost completed. It is decided that the Strategy Paper will be finalized with the results of the surveys, including the partner countries' national policies towards migrants in order to identify the prejudice and discrimination levels between migrants and natives in the cities of the partner universities. Deadlines for the analysis and country policies were reviewed. First draft of the Online Course was discussed, and online course content is revised. Deadlines for the Best Practice Guide was revised and evaluation of the student's progress for the Best Practice Competition was discussed.
